A.I.R. President to Visit A.I.R. Branches in WA

The President of the Association of Independent Retirees (A.I.R.) Limited, Theresa Kot, will join members of eight Branches of A.I.R. in Perth and surrounding districts during the next two weeks.

At meetings with members, Ms Kot will discuss a number of issues of strong concern to self-funded retirees and particularly changes to the thresholds for part-pension eligibility, the failure to achieve indexation review from the Matthews Report, and the changes to superannuation and resulting impact on the retirement savings of baby boomers.

Ms Kot will also discuss problems arising in WA in regard to 410 Visa holders with the Federal Minister for Immigration and Citizenship, Senator the Hon Chris Evans.

She will also meet with WA-based kindred organisations and groups to discuss input from the self-funded retiree sector to State Pre-Budget submissions and deliberations.
