

A.I.R. Welcomes Establishment of Peak Superannuation Advisory Group

The President of the Association of Independent Retirees (A.I.R.) Limited, Theresa Kot, has welcomed the announcement of the establishment of a Superannuation Advisory Group by the Minister for Superannuation and Corporate Law, Senator the Hon Nick Sherry.

The Association of Independent Retirees is the peak national body representing the views of fully and partly self-funded retirees. A.I.R. is a not-for-profit, volunteer organization, with branches in every State and Territory, comprising some 14,000 members.

“It is pleasing to note that the Advisory Group will be chaired by the Minister, and that its membership has a broad experience and expertise in many facets of the industry,” she said.

“Self-funded retirees have made, and continue to make, a significant contribution to this nation’s economy as taxpayers, volunteers and interstate tourists,” Ms Kot said.

“This sector will grow significantly as the baby-boomer generation reaches retirement age, and any issue affecting superannuation can be expected to have a significant effect on their status as self-funded retirees,” she said.
